In partnership with Lafayette Ready Start, the Acadiana High Library is offering storytimes to go kits for infants to 5 year olds.

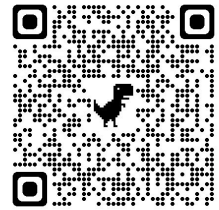

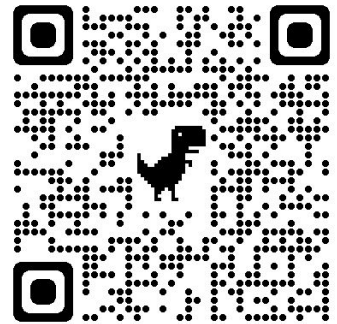
LPSS Parent & Family Engagement
