

SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS

Special meetings of the Board may be called by the president, or in his absence, the vice-president. Any requests for special meetings from individual members of the Board shall be relayed to the president for his determination. Special meetings may also be called by presenting to the superintendent a written request signed by a majority of the entire Board.

Special meetings shall not be considered an official meeting unless notice has been posted at the School Board Office and notice given by public announcement at an official Board meeting or by special written notice to all Board members. The written notice shall be deposited in the U. S. Mail at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the time of the meeting.

In the event of an extraordinary emergency, special meetings may be called by telephone and the normal notice shall not be required. However, the Board shall give notice of the meeting as it deems appropriate and circumstances permit, when such an extraordinary emergency meeting is called. At such an extra-ordinary emergency meeting, the meeting shall not be an official meeting of the Board unless a majority of the entire Board agrees to waive the normal notice requirements.

Any call for a special meeting shall specify the items to be considered and only such items shall be considered.
