

QUORUM

A majority of the membership (one more than half) shall constitute a quorum at the Regular or Special meetings of the Board.

The only action that may be taken in the absence of a quorum is to adjourn the meeting to another time in the expectation of a quorum.

Only members of the deliberative assembly shall be seated at the Board table in order to protect the integrity of the debate in view of the public.
