

## **RULES OF ORDER**

When not otherwise controlled by State law, the State Board of Education, or policies governing its operating procedures, previously adopted by the Lafayette Parish School Board, the business of the Board, for all regular and special meetings and committee meetings, shall be conducted according to the latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order, Revised, with the following exceptions.

Parliamentary rules for small boards shall not be applied to Regular Board Meetings, but only to workshops and committee meetings.

A Board Member may be recognized without standing but by raising his/her hand.

Rules of order will always take precedence over common practices.

Customs observed by the presiding officer with regard to the use of his/her title, will be at the discretion of the presiding officer.

The Vice-President of the School Board, or designee, shall serve as the parliamentarian.
