

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN BOARD MEETINGS

The Board's procedures for interested persons wishing to be heard at a Board meeting on matters relating to Board agenda items are as follows:

1. If a group of interested persons are present, the group must assign no more than two (2) speakers or representatives of the group to speak on behalf of the group.
2. All presentations are to be no longer than three (3) minutes, more or less, at the discretion of the President depending on the total number of speakers.
3. The Board will receive public input on agenda items being considered for final adoption. The public comments will be restricted to the subject matter addressed in the agenda item.
4. In addition, the public may address the Board on any matter relating to the Lafayette Parish School Board at the end of the meeting at the topic "Public Comments."
5. Public comments may be extended or shortened at the discretion of the Board.
