Board Elects Officers for 2002

The Lafayette Parish School Board elected its new president and vice president for the year 2002. Judy Cox was elected as Board President and Mike Hefner was elected as Board Vice President.

Superintendent and Board Recognize Carl LaCombe

Board Approves Resolutions

The Board approved two resolutions recognizing February 1-28 as African-American History Month and recognizing January 21 as Martin Luther King Jr. Day and honoring this day as a national holiday. The Board encourages all schools to recognize, through appropriate classroom and school activities, the contributions made by Dr. King and African-Americans that have made and continue to make toward improving society. - approved the purchase of jewelry making tools and supplies for Comeaux High School;
- approved the 2002-2003 Administrative and School Calendars;
- approved establishing Carencro High School as a voting precinct;
- approved an Act of Conveyance and Grant of Servitude to the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, which provides property for a street improvement project at Live Oak Elementary. Lafayette Consolidated Government will be widening Butcher Switch Road at the intersection with University Avenue, to provide a left turn lane. In consideration for the project, Lafayette Consolidated Government will plant eight live oak trees on the campus of Live Oak Elementary.
