## Lafayette Parish Regular Board Meeting March 21, 2001

### **Board Recognizes Alleman Student**

The Lafayette Parish School Board recognized Kesha Jean-Batiste, a student at L.J. Alleman Middle School, who was selected to represent Louisiana as a member of the 2001 Mudbugs team. The Mudbugs team travels to Canada to participate in the Windsor-Ontario International Indoor Games, courtesy of the Louisiana Department of Education.

### **Board Hears From Broussard Middle Students**

The Board was invited to attend a performance of the Broadway musical Annie, by two Broussard Middle students who are members of the cast. Annie (Allison Zerangue) also treated the Board to a performance of her song "Tomorrow" while Daddy Warbucks (Blake Landry) handed out invitations.

### **Board Approves Changes in Substitute Teacher Pay Practice**

The Board approved the revisions to the Substitute Teacher Pay Practice. The per day pay for non-degreed substitutes without CAT Test and non-degreed substitutes with CAT Test increased by \$2.05. When a substitute teacher teaches more than 15 consecutive days for the same teacher, non-degreed substitute teachers without CAT Test shall receive \$61 per day for all days taught beyond 15 days; non-degreed substitute teachers with CAT Test shall receive \$63 per day for all days taught beyond 15 days for the same teacher.

- approved the low base bid and alternate one in the amount of \$108,463 from Bernhard Mechanical for the Central Office Chiller Replacement Project;
- approved the bid from Southern Scientific for the purchase of Science Supplies and Equipment for the school district at a fixed discount;
- approved the Self-Funded Construction and Bond Fund Budget Revision #1;
- authorized the Board President to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Lafayette City-Parish Government with reference to reapportionment as outlined in a Draft Agreement;
- approved the 2000-2001 Sales Tax Fund Revised Budget #1;
- granted permission to exercise the renewal options in the Fiscal Agency contract with Hibernia National Bank.
