Lafayette Parish Regular Board Meeting April 3, 2002

Board Discussed Proposed Desegregation Plan

The Lafayette Parish School Board asked Superintendent James Easton to hold a press conference after his plan for further desegregating schools is filed in federal court. Board Members, the Superintendent and staff are under a gag order imposed by Federal Judge Richard Haik until the plan is entered into court records, making it a public document. The Board debated going into executive session to review the Superintendent's proposal and discuss Board Member requests that could be included in an addendum to the plan, also to be filed into court records. However, the Board voted not to go into executive session.

In other action, the Board:
