## Lafayette Parish Regular Board Meeting August 4, 2004

### **Board Reschedules Millage Renewal Election**

The Lafayette Parish School Board voted earlier this year to have a millage renewal election on Sept. 18, 2004. In order provide ample time to develop an information campaign for the public about the importance of the millage renewal, the Board voted to reschedule the election for Nov. 2, 2004.

### **Board Approves Employee Raise Proposal**

The Board approved a plan to provide an approximate 0.75% raise for employees. The cost of the raise for certified employees would be \$711,759, most of which would be paid through MFP funds (\$695,919); and for non-certified employees would be \$146,951; for a total of \$1,004,260.

### **Board Approves Transfers of Administrators**

The Board approved the transfer of several school-based administrators. The administrators and the schools to which they are assigned are as follows: Kathleen Anderson, principal of Carencro Heights Elementary; Carrie Angel, principal of Broussard Middle; Sandra Billeaudeau, assistant principal of Live Oak Elementary; Hayward Boone, assistant principal of Broussard Middle; Samuel Clay, assistant principal of Carencro Middle; Sandra Wilkinson, assistant principal of N.P. Moss Middle; Keicia Hawkins, assistant principal of Youngsville Middle; Phyllis Ledet, assistant principal at Myrtle Place and Westside Elementary; Monique Magee, assistant principal at Lafayette Middle; Dorothy Scott, assistant principal at Lafayette High; and Ada Thomas, assistant principal at Paul Breaux Middle.

### **In other action, the Board:**

- approved corrections of the minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of 7/21/04;
- approved the minutes of the Special Board Meeting of 8/4/04;
- approved the Sales Tax Collection Report for June, 2004;
- approved recommended personnel changes;
- approved revisions to Policy File: IID - Test Security Policy;

- granted permission to award bids for 50 digital cameras for buses and 25 trip recorder systems for buses to the lowest responsive and responsible bidders;
- approved resolution authorizing the reimbursement of capital school projects with proceeds from a future planned bond issue to allow for the start of needed and planned projects; the tentative budgetary plan is to issue School Board debt to fund immediate needs of about \$4,700,000;
- approved capital improvement fund budget revision #2 for FY2003-2004;
- approved a resolution for declaration of public emergency at Carencro Middle, which has experienced a large number of roof leaks that may affect the health and safety of students and staff and may cause severe damage to equipment and computers;
- approved \$328,500 in funding for the Carencro Middle School re-roofing project.
