Lafayette Parish Regular Board Meeting August 15, 2001

Truman Elementary Receives Donation

Dr. Rosalind Growe and Rev. Joyner of Progressive Baptist Church addressed the Lafayette Parish School Board about making a contribution to the school system. They presented a check in the amount of \$2,000 to Joan Daley, principal of Truman Elementary, to be used to address needs at the school.

- granted permission to advertise and fill the position of Clerical Assistant at Acadiana High;
- approved creating and assigning an employee to the Warehouse;
- approved the reorganization of Transportation;
- granted permission to advertise and fill the position of two Transportation Coordinators;
- approved advertising and awarding oil, gas, and mineral lease for two school sites in south Lafayette;
- approved the lease of J.W. James facilities to the Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Department;
- approved purchasing the Integrate Pro Electronic Gradebook and reimbursing the schools that have already purchased it through General Fund Allocation or School Activity Fund; the Board also voted that the Integrate Pro Electronic Gradebook purchased by a grant not be reimbursed;
- granted permission to advertise and fill the position of Clerical Assistant in Student Services;
- granted permission to create, advertise and fill the position of one Clerical Assistant at Truman Elementary and one-half Clerical Assistant at J.W. Faulk Elementary and asked that an assessment be made of the clerical needs of the school system and bring it back to the Board;
- approved the 2001-2002 Capital Improvement Fund Budget Revision #1.
