## Lafayette Parish Regular Board Meeting October 3, 2001

### **Board Recognized Youngsville Middle FCCLA Teacher and Students**

The Lafayette Parish School Board recognized Dawn Gary, a Family and Consumer Sciences teacher at Youngsville Middle, and several of her students for receiving national honors. Dawn received the Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) Spirit of Advising Award at the National FCCLA Leadership Meeting in July. Six of her students received gold medals while at the national meeting. They were Kadie Semar, Courtney Geary, Tanya McBride, Kendra Bourque, Alyse Shadle and Tricia Trahan. One student, Kay Miller, received a silver medal.

### **Board Approves Resolution**

The Board approved a resolution recognizing the month of October, 2001, as Child Search/ChildNet Awareness Month. The Department of Education, Health and Hospitals, and Social Services of the state of Louisiana, the Louisiana Interagency Coordinating Council, and public and private providers are working together under the auspices of ChildNet to implement a statewide, comprehensive, coordinated, multi-disciplinary, interagency program of early intervention services for infants and toddlers with special needs and their families. The Louisiana Child Search Project, the Division of Special Populations of the Department of Education, the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, and the public schools of the State of Louisiana are working to offer our children special help so that they can obtain an appropriate education.
