

THE DAVID AND JEANNIE PRICE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

HISTORY

The David and Jeannie Price Scholarship Fund was established in November of 2007 by Mr. David Price through the Baton Rouge Area Foundation. Mr. Price wanted to honor his alma mater, the University of Missouri and the city in which he had a successful career, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are made available to provide scholarships to full time juniors or seniors pursuing an undergraduate degree in business at either Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge or University of Missouri in Columbia or who maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5.

AWARD

Each year, up to ten scholarships will be awarded to qualified candidates attending Louisiana State University, and ten scholarships will be awarded to qualified candidates attending the University of Missouri. Each scholarship shall be a one-time award of \$3,000.

REQUIREMENTS

In addition to submitting the Common Application, applicants must submit the following:

- Transcript
- ACT/SAT
- Academic Resume
- Personal Statement or Essay
- Letter of Recommendation from the applicant's employer or internship supervisor
- Letter of Recommendation from one of the applicant's professors

DEADLINE

Applications must be submitted by April 15. All applicants will be notified of the Committee's decisions within two months of the due date.
