## Eligibility Requirement to run for an office:

\*\*\*\*The point requirement will only be exempt for the 2020-2021 year due to the restrictions from the pandemic. All requirements will resume with the 2021-2022 school year. You must be a Senior in good standing with two years on the Student Council (New for 2020- must have attended the State convention) to run for Eboard President and Vice-President. For the offices of Senior class President and Vice-President, you must be in good standing with one year on the Student council.

**Elected Positions available:** (See revised job descriptions - posted in LHS Elections Google Classroom)

**Executive Board** - President, Vice-President (*only Seniors*), - Secretary, Parliamentarian (*Juniors and Seniors*)

**Each Grade Level** - President, Vice-President, Secretary, Parliamentarian, Sgt. at Arms (2 available), Representatives (8 available)

*\*All first year freshmen are eligible to seek office for the 2020-21 Freshman Class. Students can not have more than 2 disciplinary referrals to run for any office. Those students who are elected must meet continuing eligibility requirements.*

**Friday October 23 by 1:45 p.m.:** **Deadline** for turning in permission slip to Mr. Billeaudeau in Room 507. Please do not wait until the last minute. It may be turned in anytime before. If you are absent from school, **you must make arrangements with someone to get it to Mr. Billeaudeau by 1:45 p.m.** The permission form must be properly, accurately, and completely filled out.

**Monday, October 26, 2020 :** The list of candidates will be posted in the LHS Elections Google Classroom to check the ballot for the correct spelling of names and proper placement on the ballot. Campaign rules will also be posted at this point. All questions should be directed to Mr. Billeaudeau or Mr. Cole in a timely fashion.

**Monday November 2, 2020 :** DEADLINE FOR TURNING IN A VIDEO, AUDIO RECORDING, OR A TEXT COPY OF YOUR SPEECH. *If you fail to submit a video, audio recording, or a text speech by the deadline, you will be disqualified.*

**Wednesday November 4, November 5 , Monday November 9 & Tuesday November 10-** Campaign days.

**Wednesday, November 11, Videos/Audio Recordings/Text Copy of Speeches:** Social Studies classes will post where these can be found, and viewed.

**Thursday November 12, 2020:** Students will vote with their social studies class. If available, the results will be announced **Friday November 13, 2020.**
