Dear CMMES Parents and Guardians.

Welcome to the 2023–2024 school year! It is my hope that this letter finds all of you well and ready for a fantastic school year! We are excited to get back on campus with our little Mustangs! Our students and staff did a wonderful job of working hard and making our school a happy place to be last year. We are looking forward to another year that is just as successful!

We want to wish Mrs. Anna Kedinger a great year! She is going to be the assistant principal at Duson Elementary. Mrs. Colleen Comeaux is our new assistant principal. Please help us in welcoming her to her new position.

Within this letter, you will find answers to our most frequently asked questions as well as some important dates. From this date forward, we will send out information as it becomes available through schoolwide text messages. We want you to know that we can't wait to greet your children! As always, one thing remains constant: Your children's education and safety are our first priority!

Schedule for Intake/Dismissal

6:30 - Before Care available (more information below)

7:25 - Drop Off begins

7:50 – Breakfast Ends

7:55 - Tardy Bell/Classroom Instruction Begins

3:10 - Dismissal begins

3:40 - Latest car rider pick up

3:40 - Latest bus pick-up (tentative - will be adjusted within the first few days of school)

*No check-outs after 2:50 ρ .m. This will be strictly enforced. This is in place so that teachers can ensure the safest transition at the end of the day.

Visitor Restriction: Please note that visitors will be allowed on campus for scheduled meetings and scheduled school functions. There will be no classroom visits unless it is a scheduled event like Grandparents' Day or a class ceremony.

Any visitors coming on campus with bags must have clear bags, or they must be left in your vehicle. Please know you will be asked to place bags that are not clear in your vehicle before you are allowed entry.

LPSS Bag Policy

The doors will be locked at all times. Please press the button outside of the main doors to alert our front office that you have arrived and of why you are at the school. You will be helped as soon as possible.

All visitors, no matter the reason, must go directly to the front office upon arrival.

Late Check-In/Early Check Out

The same process that we used last year will still be in place when school starts.

- <u>Late Check-In</u> Late check-in begins at 7:55. If you arrive at 7:55 or later, park and enter the building through the main entrance. You will press the buzzer on the doors. Go to the window to sign-in your student. Mrs. Cheryl will provide your student with a check-in slip and they will then go to class. Parents will not go beyond the front office. PLEASE NOTE: BREAKFAST ENDS AT 7:50.
- <u>Early Check-Out</u> Park in the front parking lot, walk to the front doors and press the buzzer. The doors will be locked to anyone outside. An office staff member will greet you via intercom and then allow entry to check your ID and have you sign the check-out log. Your child will be released to you once identification is verified. This must occur before 2:50. Otherwise, you will be directed to the car rider line. This will be strictly enforced.

CMMES Extended Care - *Changes since last year*

REACH Extended Care in the afternoons will begin on August 10, 2023 (if your paperwork has been completed/returned).

- After Care is from 3:30pm 5:30pm. The price for this service is \$135/month for full time care. A picture ID will be necessary for check out no exceptions. **Drop-ins are allowed at the rate of \$12 a day. Payments are due on the 1st of each month.
- Afternoon Extended Care is being offered by REACH. If you have questions, they can be sent to reach@lusfiber.net. A link to the registration form has been attached. This form needs to be mailed to 100 Felecie Drive, Lafayette, La 70506. Please note this paperwork is necessary for your student to start attending.

Extended Care in the morning will still be available through the school. This will begin August 10, 2023. The cost is \$50 a month. Payments are due within the first five days of the month.

- Before care students should be dropped off at the cafeteria door entry. Drop-off begins at 6:30.
 NOTE: YOU <u>CAN NOT</u> DROP OFF AFTER 7:15. If you arrive after 7:15, you will be directed to car rider line.

LPSS Dress Code

The LPSS dress code will be followed as written. Please make special note that <u>hoodies will not be</u> <u>permitted</u>. Also, backpack and lunchbox policy has changed. We are requiring clear/solid mesh bags. <u>LPSS Dress Code Policy</u>

CMMES Safety Protocols

It is our mission to provide the safest environment possible for your child each day. In pursuing this, we have developed many safety protocols and procedures that will be implemented throughout the year. Below is an outline of the plans that have been made thus far.

- Car Riders We have developed a two-lane pick-up/drop-off system. You will enter the staff parking lot from Starling. Please do not block the intersection. Exiting cars will yield to oncoming traffic until the cars have filled the parking lot. When you enter the gates, drivers will split into two lanes that will flow into the pavilion area. We will unload six cars at a time. If you are not one of the first three cars in each lane, please be prepared to stop a safe distance away from the unloading vehicles to wait to advance to the pavilion. Once all 6 cars are unloaded, the cars in the left lane will go straight through the front parking lot to Kaliste Saloom. The vehicles that are in the right lane will turn right out of the parking lot and proceed to Kaliste Saloom from Starling. This process will help us to expedite the car rider process.
 - Please bear with us in the first few days, as safety will be our priority. This may cause the line to move slowly. It is important to us that your children are safe. Someone will be outside the first two days handing out car rider tags. Please write your child's first and last name in black marker in the center. These tags must be displayed from the time you enter the line until your child is in your car. Duty teachers will call students to the car once all vehicles have stopped. Please do not call your child to get into the vehicle before they are instructed to do so. This ensures we move efficiently and safely. Everything we do in car rider is for the safety of your child. If there is no tag visible, you will be asked to park and go to the front office to show your ID. Thank you for understanding and adhering to our protocols.
- <u>Buzzer at Front Entrance</u> When you come to school to check your child out, or to attend a
 meeting you will need to be buzzed in. Our doors remain locked all day. You must have your ID with
 you to access your child.

August 14, 2023	All Students in Attendance K - 5 Kindergarten Meet and Greet - 9:00am - 9:45am
