

**ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL  
TENURE**

The teacher tenure law is applicable to principals and supervisors, who hold tenure in their positions; heads of major departments and directors in positions requiring certification may hold tenure as supervisors; assistant principals may hold tenure only as teachers. The tenure law does not apply to the superintendent, assistant superintendent or any principals, supervisors, heads of major departments and directors in positions requiring certification who were appointed on or after July 1, 1985 (L.R.S. 17:444 (B), as amended by Act 988 of 1985).
