

DRESS CODE FOR BUS DRIVERS AND BUS ATTENDANTS

The Lafayette Parish School Board recognizes that public assessment of the Lafayette Parish School System is influenced by the image and personal appearance of its employees. Further, appropriate personal appearance enhances the authority role of those who supervise students.

It is the responsibility of each employee to contribute to the formation of a positive, businesslike, professional public image by maintaining high standards of personal appearance through appropriate dress and grooming.

Each school bus driver and bus attendant employed with the Lafayette Parish School Board is expected to give proper attention to his/her personal appearance as required by work responsibilities.

1. Leisure, recreational and athletic type clothing (shorts, warm-up suits, etc.) are prohibited. Tank tops, short skirts, flip flops and open back shoes are not to be worn.
2. Uniform shorts with coordinated shirts are permitted.

Principals are instructed to be aware of employee dress and to discuss dress expectations with those employees who may require guidance.
