

ASSIGNMENT OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

- I. Any elementary building with any group of grades between K-5 should have an assistant principal when the enrollment reaches 600 students.
- II. Any elementary building with either grades 6th, 7th or 8th should have an assistant principal when the enrollment reaches 500 students.
- III. In those few cases where the elementary enrollment declines after an assistant principal has been appointed to the building, there shall be a one (1) year grace period during which the administrator will work with the principal to either reassign the assistant principal or develop a part-time teacher and part-time assistant principal position for the building.
