

PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL HEALTH EXAMINATIONS

The Board shall require all new employees to present prior to the end of the first calendar month of employment as a condition of employment in the parish, a physician's certificate attesting to their freedom from communicable disease. This certificate shall include tuberculin skin test results. For test results other than negative, chest x-ray results must be included.

Additionally, the Board authorizes the Superintendent to require any employee to have a medical examination whenever deemed necessary for the health and welfare of children or to ascertain need or desirability for sick leave or maternity leave.
