

NONPROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL HEALTH EXAMINATIONS

The Board shall require all new non-certificated employees to present as a condition of employment in the district, a physician's certificate attesting to their freedom from communicable diseases, including tuberculosis as shown through a negative tuberculin test or chest x-ray. The cost of the physical examination will be reimbursed to the employee by the School Board up to a maximum of \$35.00.

Additionally, the Board authorizes the Superintendent to require any employee to have a medical examination whenever deemed necessary for the health and welfare of children, or to ascertain need or desirability for sick leave or maternity leave. The cost of this examination will be the responsibility of the School Board.

Such additional examinations and tests shall be required of school bus operators as the State Board of Education may specify.

The Board shall require and provide for a general physical examination for all custodians and maintenance employees prior to their employment. The cost of the physical examination will be reimbursed to the employee by the School Board up to a maximum of \$35.00.
