

CURRICULUM ADOPTION

The Lafayette Parish School Board is ultimately responsible for the curriculum of the elementary and secondary schools of the parish.

The superintendent, as the chief administrative officer of the school system, is authorized to approve courses and programs, provided they meet the requirements and recommendations of the State Board of Education, as set forth in Bulletin #741.

However, the establishment of a new instructional department, the deletion of an existing department, or any major change in a program shall require Board approval. Approval of the State Department of Education shall also be obtained for all new programs.
