

ADULT AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION

The Board authorizes the use of school facilities for the purpose of developing a broad program of adult and community education for the parish.

The Adult Education Program shall be administered and conducted in accordance with the Adult Education Act of 1966, as amended, Public Law 95-561 and R.S. 17:14 (Act 274 of 1975 as amended) of the 1982 session of the Louisiana Legislature, the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act of 1998 (Title II of the Workforce Investment Act) and with regulations established by the Bureau of Adult Education of the State Department of Education.

Graduation requirements for adults shall be those required by the State and set forth in Bulletin #741 of the State Department of Education.

Eligible students who are enrolled in the regular school program may be placed in the Adult Education Program with written parental consent. Referrals must be initiated by the school counselor of the principal.

Community Education Programs shall be conducted based upon community needs and interest.
