

HOMework

The following recommendations will assist the school in handling homework assignments:

1. The teacher may use incentives to encourage the child to complete his/her work. (i.e. charts, rewards, etc.)
2. The teacher may use the weekly report letter or a progress report letter to notify parents of student work habits.
3. Administrators and teachers may work within the school setting to encourage students to complete homework assignments not completed at the designated time. (i.e. recess, noon detention, etc.)
4. The teacher will notify the parents of a problem that is ongoing. (i.e. mid six weeks, by phone, progress report or request parent signature as verification of having received information.)
5. Students may be given points for doing homework. These points can be used as one test grade for a six week period. This test grade should not exceed one fifth (1/5) of the total six week grade.
