

RECOGNITION OF HONOR GRADUATES

The administration and faculty of each high school will determine the most appropriate method of recognizing students, during graduation ceremonies, who have achieved academic distinction. Members of the National Honor Society will be seated on the stage and will be recognized in alphabetical order not only for their scholastic attainments, but also for service to the school and community as required of National Honor Society members.

Calculations for the Superintendent's Award will be based upon numeric averages rather than quality points. The final numerical average for a course will be multiplied by a conversion factor for the Superintendent's Award purposes only.

The conversion factors are as follows:

- Regular courses (1.00)
- Honors courses (1.02)
- Gifted/Advanced Placement courses (1.04)

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
