

## SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

All children having legal domicile in Lafayette Parish or who are under the care, custody (granted by a district court), and control of a resident thereof, shall be entitled to free education in the public schools of Lafayette Parish.

In keeping with state law, the school administration shall require that all children, upon entering the parish schools for the first time, be required to present a copy of their official birth record or other such evidence of age as permitted by law.

The school administration shall also be responsible for implementing the statutory requirements that each child entering the public school system for the first time, including those who enroll in any preschool program or kindergarten, present evidence of such medical tests and immunizations as required by law. (See Policy File: JGCA)

School admission must be in compliance with the consent decree with the federal courts. (See Policy File: JBCCA-R)
