

STUDENT SMOKING POLICY

Students shall not be permitted to have tobacco and/or tobacco paraphernalia in their possession, or to use tobacco products on the school grounds, or in school buildings during the school day, or at school activities held after school hours, or when riding school buses to and from school. Parental permission to use tobacco or have tobacco paraphernalia does not exempt a student from this policy.

MIDDLE SCHOOL SMOKING DISCIPLINE PROCEDURE

First offense – Student will be assigned to attend the Smoking Program, CHOICES. A parent/guardian must attend this session with the student. Should the student fail to attend the program, he/she will receive a one day suspension.

Subsequent violations of the smoking policy will result in a one day suspension or a recommended expulsion; depending on the student's disciplinary record.

HIGH SCHOOL SMOKING DISCIPLINE PROCEDURE

First Offense – Student will be assigned to attend the Smoking Program, CHOICES. A parent/guardian must attend the session with the student. Should the student fail to attend the program, he/she will receive a one day suspension.

Subsequent violations of the smoking policy will result in the student being referred to the Board's adopted discipline procedures.
