

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL-SPONSORED TRIPS

Students who go on off-campus trips sponsored by the school, whether during the school day or overnight, are under the immediate jurisdiction of the school. In order to insure behavior that will be a credit to the schools of Lafayette Parish and to each individual school community, the following regulations will be in effect beginning of the 1974-75 session:

1. On field trips there shall be:
 - a. No alcoholic beverages.
 - b. No illegal drugs.
 - c. No smoking.
 - d. No profanity.
2. Students shall adhere to the School Board dress policy at all times (see JCDB).
3. On overnight field trips there shall be a minimum of one teacher acting as chaperone for every 15 students.
4. Sponsors shall have a right to enforce curfews on their group or on certain individuals within the group.
5. Sponsors shall have a right to regulate when and where a student may go while on the trip.
6. Sponsors shall have the right to refuse to take certain students on the trip who have demonstrated an unwillingness to cooperate.
7. Unless a student leaves on a school-sponsored trip under the direct supervision of the school, the school will not be responsible for the student.

Since student behavior on these trips reflect on the integrity of the entire student body, punishment for irresponsibility, dishonesty, or immoral conduct should be accordingly severe.
