

## **STUDENT IMMUNIZATIONS**

In compliance with state law, all children entering the Lafayette Parish Public School System for the first time, including preschool level and kindergarten, shall present satisfactory evidence of having been immunized against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, poliomyelitis, measles, mumps, rubella and Hepatitis B. Documented evidence of immunization or active immunization program in progress, must be presented at the time of Registration. No student will be allowed to register until this requirement is met.

Any student transferring from another school system in or out of the state, must submit documented evidence of immunization before they can be enrolled in this school system.

School personnel shall be responsible for checking student records to see that provisions as outlined above are enforced.

Exceptions to any of the above requirements will be made only if parent or guardian submits signed documentation from a physician stating that it is medically contraindicated for the student to be immunized; or if parent or guardian provides a written dissent due to religious or personnel belief.
