**A. INFORMATION REPORTS**

- a. Curriculum Update

An executive summary on the Department of Athletics was presented by James Simmons, Jr., CAA, Director, Health, P.E. and Driver's Ed. Mr. Simmons informed the Board that the school system consists of thirteen (13) male sports and twelve (12) female sports. Also, participation in middle and high school sports has a positive effect on student athletes' long term personal success. The District does an internal assessment on female programs in compliance with Title IX of the Educational Amendment Act of 1972.

- b. Use of Inmate Labor in Schools

Kyle Bordelon, Acting Director of Maintenance, informed the Board that a committee of three principals, one Area Director and three Head Custodians had been formed to discuss issues, experiences and concerns regarding the use of inmate labor on campuses. A method of funding such a program will be discussed and input will be requested from the Finance Department.

- c. LPSS Summer Reading Guidelines

Burnell Lemoine, Deputy Superintendent and Chief Academic Officer, informed the Board that in order to increase opportunities for all students to engage in effective summer reading and become life-long readers, a committee had been formed to address inequities among summer reading programs throughout the parish. The summer reading guidelines are intended to provide support to schools in the implementation of their respective summer reading programs.
