Motion (Sam, Babineaux) that the Board approve Child Nutrition Services increasing the meal prices for elementary, middle, and high schools effective with the 2008-2009 school year as follows: Breakfast: Elementary, Middle, and High Schools – increase from \$0.75/meal to \$1.00/meal; Adult (LPSS Employee) – increase from \$1.25/meal to \$1.75/meal; Adult (Visitor) – increase from \$1.50/meal to \$2.00/meal; Lunch: Elementary increase from \$1.00/meal to \$1.25/meal; Middle & High Schools – increase from \$1.25/meal to \$1.50/meal; Adult (LPSS Employee) – increase from \$2.25/meal to \$2.75/meal; Adult (Visitor) – increase from \$2.50/meal to \$3.00/meal. Motion carried.
