The Chair called the meeting to order.

I. APPEAL HEARING. . .JANE RICHARD, TEACHER, LIVE OAK ELEMENTARY

The Chair asked the party involved if they wanted an open or a closed session. The party requested that the hearing be held in closed session.

Motion (Hardy, Hefner) that the Board go into executive session to hear the case of Jane Richard, teacher at Live Oak Elementary. Motion carried.

Ms. Richard’s attorney filed an Objection to Proceedings based on the letter from the Superintendent not being sufficient in describing the charges brought against the employee.

After some discussion, the Board attorney informed the Board that they could proceed with the appeal hearing of Ms. Richard.

Motion (Hefner, Hardy) that the Board go back into regular session. Motion carried.

Motion (Hefner, Cox) that the Board uphold staff’s recommendation to terminate Jane Richard, teacher at Live Oak Elementary for actions considered to be in violation of Teacher Tenure Act, R.S. 17:443. Motion carried.
