

**LAFAYETTE PARISH SCHOOL BOARD

The School Board of the Parish of Lafayette, State of Louisiana, met in special session at its regular meeting place, the Lafayette Parish School Board Administrative Building, Board Room, Lafayette, Louisiana, on Wednesday, February 16, 2005 at 1:30 P. M., pursuant to notice given in writing to every member.

The President called the meeting to order.

I. APPEAL HEARING. . . CHERYL MOSS, LPN

The Chair asked the party involved if they wanted an open or a closed session. The party requested that the hearing be held in closed session.

Motion (Guidry, Hefner) that the Board go into executive session. Motion carried.

Motion (Hardy, Sam) that the Board go back into regular session. Motion carried.

Motion (Cox, Hefner) that the Board accept staff's recommendation to terminate Cheryl Moss, LPN.

A substitute motion was made by Guidry, and seconded by Sam that Cheryl Moss, LPN be allowed to keep her job, and that she be excused from escorting students on the bus between sites.

The Chair called for a roll call vote on the substitute motion. Voting for were Guidry, Hardy and Sam. Voting against were Cox, Gibson, Hefner and Thibodaux. Motion failed. LaCombe and Wilson were absent.

A substitute motion was made by Guidry, and seconded by Sam that Cheryl Moss, LPN be offered another position as a teacher assistant at her same salary.

The Chair called for a roll call vote on the substitute motion. Voting for were Guidry, Sam and Thibodaux. Voting against were Cox, Gibson, Hardy and Hefner. Motion failed. LaCombe and Wilson were absent.

The Chair called for a roll call vote on the original motion for termination. Voting for were Cox, Gibson, Hardy and Hefner. Voting against were Guidry and Thibodaux. Motion carried. Sam abstained. LaCombe and Wilson were absent.

There being no further business, it was moved by Guidry, seconded by Hardy, and carried that the meeting adjourn.
