The Chair informed the Committee that the meeting had been called for the purpose of hearing expulsion cases.

I. CASE #SL

The Chair asked the party involved if they wanted an open or a closed session. The party requested that the hearing be held in closed session.

Motion (Hardy, Hefner) that the Board go into executive session to hear Case #SL. Motion carried.

Motion (Hardy/Cox) that the Board go back into regular session. Motion carried.

The Chair called for a roll call vote on the substitute motion. Voting for were Cox, Gibson, Hefner and Sam. Voting against were Hardy and Wilson. Motion carried.
