-No jeans

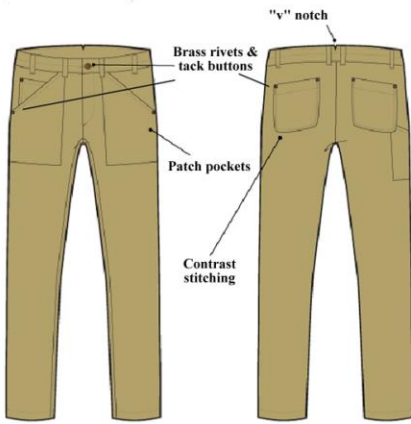
